

# India aims for bright start

## Take on Australia in HWL opener today

India will look to continue their good run under new coach Sjoerd Marjine when they take on defending champions Australia in their opening match in the Hockey World League (HWL) Final at the Kalinga Stadium here on Friday.

India finished third in the last edition of the meet, losing to the Netherlands 2-3 on penalties after both teams were locked 5-5 in regulation time.

Under new coach Sjoerd Marjine, a young Indian team would be playing at home for the first time.

"No pressure, nothing at all. Before the match I will prepare them to the best of my ability but I cannot control the outcome of the game. So, when I walk out onto the field on Friday, I will just enjoy the crowd," the coach had said when asked about pressure before the first game.

To name a few, India have the likes of Harmanpreet Singh, Dipsan Tirkey, Sumit Varun Kumar among the young faces for this competition.

"All the young players have potential and that's why they are with the team. Now it's normal for most of the youngsters to reach a high level and then fall. But what's important is how they cope with the fall and learn from it because with all the expectations, it's normal for them to fall at times," Marjine said.

"It's about the mindset and belief. You have to believe that

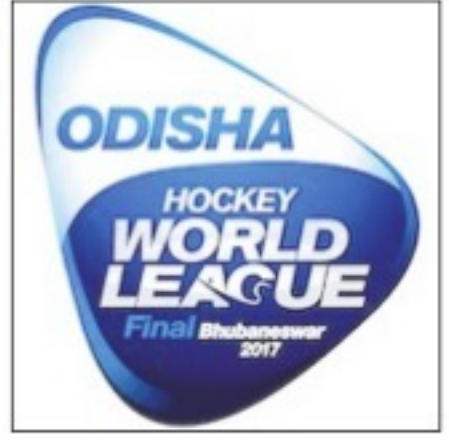
you can win and the team is doing that. We will have to show that on the pitch. It will not be easy but we are up for the challenge," said the Dutchman when asked about India's disappointing international record against other seven participating teams of the HWL Final.

India will have to fight it out against top teams like Australia, Netherlands, Germany, England, Belgium, Argentina and Spain in the HWL final.

The Asia Cup victory was the perfect start to the tenure of Marjine, who will be hoping his side can reproduce that excellent form.

The winners of the event in Bhubaneswar will also guarantee qualification for the Men's Champions Trophy

2018, which will take place in the Netherlands in June/July. Barring a few occasional losses, India have been ruling the roost in the continent, the



most recent among the triumphs being the Asia Cup crown in Dhaka earlier this year.

But once a giant of the game

with as many eight Olympic gold medals, India would be striving to ensure that they are seen as more than a regional bigwig.

Against world No. 2 Australia, India have had limited success in recent times. India have lost to the Kookaburras in the Champions Trophy, Azlan Shah and Commonwealth Games in the last few years. And it would be a Herculean task to upstage the mighty Australians in the opening game of the eight-nation tournament featuring all the top teams of the world.

The HWL final, in fact, will be the first real test for Marjine, who took over just two months ago from the legendary Roelant Oltmans.

Marjine might have tasted success in his first assignment – the Asia Cup – but the HWL Final will be a completely different ballgame for him.

Since taking charge, Marjine hasn't made any major change to the playing style or strategy of the team.

Instead, the only new thing or idea he has brought into the side is letting the players decide the style of hockey they want to play. He has focussed on backroom preparation, a method which has put more responsibility on the shoulders of the players.

Marjine's style of working seems to be delivering at least going by the results of the Asia Cup, a title which India won after 10 years, beating Malaysia 2-1 in the final.

## FIFA reveals secrets of World Cup draw to avoid foul play

Global football governing body FIFA has revealed plans for the Russia 2018 World Cup draw, to be held on Friday at the Kremlin.

Russian journalist Maria Komandnaya will present the event with the help of Uruguayan football legend Diego Forlan.

Forlan stated that the expectations of the draw are very high as "Everybody wants to know – the fans, the people want to know, where to book hotels and plane tickets." Yet, Forlan denied that the draw is decisive as to who will advance in the tournament. He recalled that in the previous World Cup, Uruguay went to the same group as England and that Costa Rica was in the same group as Italy.

Nonetheless, it was the Uruguayan and Costa Ricans who surprisingly qualified for the round of 16. FIFA has already distributed the 32 teams between four levels, each level including eight teams.

During the Friday draw, eight teams per level will be divided down into smaller four team groups. After the draw, there will then be a total of eight groups, with four teams per group. Since Russia is the host country, it is the only team to already know its place in the draw.

# India wins 3 gold, 4 silver, 2 bronze in Asian Archery

Indian archers produced an impressive performance, grabbing three gold, four silver and two bronze medals at the Asian Championships here on Thursday.

Two Indian boys and girls also booked quota places for the 2018 Youth Olympics.

15-year-old Haryana girl Himani Kumari defeated her Mongolian opponent Bayasgalan Badamjuani 7-1 in the recurve cadet bronze play-off to bag the quota.

Earlier in an all-Indian cadet recurve final, 14-year-old Akash, who also belongs to Haryana, defeated Dhiraj Bommadevara of Andhra Pradesh 6-4 to bag the boys' quota for the Youth Olympics in Argentina.

This tournament also serves as the 2018 Youth Olympics in Buenos Aires. Trailing 0-4 after two sets, Akash held his nerve to win three sets and finished with three perfect 10s for a brilliant gold medal triumph.

Recurve senior men's team of Jayanta Talukdar, Atanu Das and Yashdev lost to their Korean rivals 1-5 to settle for a silver. India also bagged two gold medals in the non-Olympic compound discipline. Abhishek Verma beat Korean rival Kim Jongho to win the gold and prevent a clean sweep of individual crowns by Korea.

"I did my best. Everybody prepared to get this achievement to get this medal, and right now it's just a good feeling," said Verma, who was runner-up at the 2014 Asian Games in Incheon.

"We are already preparing for Asian Games (in Jakarta in 2018) just like we did last time, because we did very well. We'd like to repeat the same result this time, and every time."

Indian women's compound team of Jyothi Surekha Vennam, Trisha Deb and Parveena beat So Chaewon, Choi Bomin and Song Yun Soo 230-227 to win the gold medal.

Verma, however, could not inspire India to a compound team gold as he along with Gurwinder Singh and Rajat Chauhan lost by two points to the Korean team of Jongho, Choi Yonghee and Kim Taeyoon, who totalled 234.

## Witness explains how bribes were paid to officials

An Argentinian accountant described how he handled the payment of millions of dollars in bribes to former South American soccer officials, including former FIFA Vice President Julio Grondona, by using wire transfers, offshore accounts and money couriers.

Eladio Rodriguez, who kept track of finances and bribe payments at the Argentinian sports marketing company Torneos and Competencias, testified for hours in New York in the federal corruption trial of the former soccer heads of Paraguay, Peru and Brazil.

The company, along with two others, made the payments to obtain the rights to broadcast tournaments and matches.

Rodriguez said it was necessary to pay bribes to maintain a good relationship with CONMEBOL (South America's soccer governing body) and to obtain the signing of contracts.

The cash payments to Grondona were made after Torneos deposited money into overseas accounts of exchange remittance businesses. Money couriers would then take the money to Torneos in Buenos Aires and Grondona's chauffeur normally would pick it up, Rodriguez said.

### PM Modi congratulates Advani for world title

**NEW DELHI:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday congratulated Indian star Pankaj Advani for clinching his 18th world title after claiming the IBSF World Snooker Championship. Advani outclassed Iran's Amir Sarkhosh 8-2 in the finals of the event at the Al Arabi Sports Club in Doha on Monday. Prime Minister Modi, on his official Twitter account, wrote, "Congratulations @PankajAdvani247 for winning your 18th world title in the recently concluded IBSF World Snooker Championship. Your accomplishments make us very proud."

### Syria's Omar Kharbin named Asian Player of the Year

**BANGKOK:** Syrian footballer Omar Kharbin was named the AFC men's Player of the Year 2017, while Japanese Takafumi Hori won the men's Coach of the Year title here on Wednesday. The Syria forward has made 36 appearances for his national team scoring 16 goals since 2016. He plays for the Al-Hilal in Saudi Professional League. The 23-year-old also became the first Syrian ever to win the Asian Footballer of the Year on Wednesday. AFC Player of the Year: Omar Kharbin Congratulations, AFC tweeted. Among the other awards, Korean Son Heung-min was named International Player of the Year, Lee Seungwoo the men's Youth Player of the Year and Samantha Kerr given the Women's Player of the Year title.

### Pune wins thriller against Mumbai in ISL

**PUNE:** Emiliano Alfaro scored a winner in the 93rd minute as FC Pune City and Mumbai City FC produced some brilliant end-to-end football at the Balwadi on Wednesday night derby which ended 2-1 in favour of Pune at Indian Super League. Diego Carlos scampared away after Mumbai's high defensive line was caught out of position three minutes into injury time and laid it off perfectly for Alfaro to tap into the back of the net and break the hearts of Mumbai City fans. Pune were trailing when Balwant Singh cut in from the right to send a stunning shot into the corner of the net in the 15th minute.

# Arsenal pounds Huddersfield

Olivier Giroud had a brace and Mesut Ozil contributed a goal and two assists as Arsenal overwhelmed Huddersfield Town 5-0 to hang on to fourth place in the English Premier League (EPL).

Their third consecutive league win brings the Gunners to 28 points, just four behind their next opponents, second-place Manchester United, who will visit London's Emirates Stadium on Saturday.

The German international set up substitute Giroud in the 68th minute and contributed to Alexis Sanchez's goal a minute later before making it 4-0 in the 72nd

Newly promoted Huddersfield conceded inside the first three minutes, as Arsenal's Alexander Lacazette scored on a beautiful backheel shot.

The visitors remained in the contest until Ozil caught fire in the final quarter, assisting on two goals and scoring himself in an interval of just under four minutes.

The German international set up substitute Giroud in the 68th minute and contributed to Alexis Sanchez's goal a minute later before making it 4-0 in the 72nd

minute to cap his best-ever performance in an EPL match.

Giroud added a fifth goal in the 87th.

Ten kilometres away at Stamford Bridge, third-placed Chelsea eked out a 1-0 win over Swansea, currently in the drop zone.

The defending champion Blues were more dominant than the score would indicate and the Swans owed the respectable score line to the heroics of goalkeeper Lukasz Fabianski, who made outstanding stops against William, Alvaro Morata and Pedro.

Chelsea coach Antonio Conte was sent to the stands a few minutes before half-time after protesting the official's decision to award Swansea goal kick when he thought his side had won a corner.

The winning goal came in the 55th minute, when Antonio Rudiger headed the ball past Fabianski after Swansea's Wilfrid Bony blocked the initial shot by N'Golo Kante.

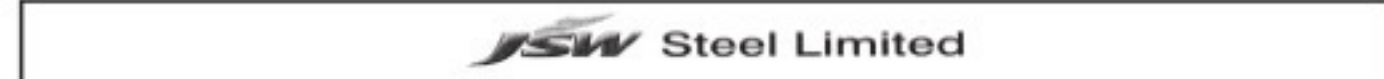
